REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION

On June 5, 2020, the undersigned was informed by the child's mother and ICPC worker, [REDACTED] that the child was hospitalized due to suicidal ideations. [REDACTED] reported that she was completing her monthly compliance contact with the child and during the contact, the child stated she wanted to kill herself. Ms. Young informed the mother to take the child to the hospital and have her evaluated. The mother took the child to the hospital and she was admitted to [REDACTED]

On June 11, 2020, the undersigned spoke with the child's mother. The child's mother reported that the child was still hospitalized. The child's mother reported that a family therapy session was scheduled on June 10, 2020; however, the child did not want to participate. The mother reported that the hospital was recommending the child be admitted to a residential treatment center. The mother reported she was in agreement with this recommendation.

On June 11, 2020, the undersigned spoke with the hospital therapist, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated that the child was refusing to participate in individual and group therapy. [REDACTED] reported that the child was still making statements to self-harm; therefore, the hospital was not ready to release her. [REDACTED] reported that they were recommending a residential treatment center for the child; however, they were not sure if there would be immediate openings for the child. [REDACTED] reported that the child's medication of Abilify was increased.

On June 15, 2020, the undersigned the Senior Social Services Supervisor Stacey Metcalf received the following email that the Interstate Compact for the Placement of Children (ICPC) Orange County liaison forwarded from the ICPC Team Lead in Texas:

Hello

Placement has disrupted. Please make arrangements for the child's return to CA. The parent does not want the child placed in the home. The child still remains in the hospital and the hospital is recommending the child be placed in RTC.
